## Bike Shop: Open Hours and Community Repair

- **Open Hours:** Every Thursday from 4-8pm, our Bike Shop is open to our community for open hours. You are welcome to drop in for free instruction on maintaining your own bike. Open hours are perfect for tackling flats and tune-ups where the individual wishes to learn about and be involved in the process. No previous mechanics experience is necessary!
- **Bike Repair Drop-off:** We will have a limited number of slots per week for bike repair drop-offs on a first-come, first-serve basis. Drop-off repairs may take 1-2 weeks to complete.
- **December Bike Fix-a-Thon:** Our next Bike Fix-A-Thon is scheduled for Sunday, December 12, 2021. We are able to accept up to 30 bikes, first-come, first-served. Participants will leave their bikes at The Crucible during the time of service and will be available for pick up upon confirmation the week following.
